As Kapisanan shifts into centering practices of anti-oppression and decolonization, the Board is considering a more decentralized model of leadership, with the various committees and any contract staff taking on more responsibilities for planning and implementation activities.

- Time commitment: 1 hour/quarter for Board Meetings (and Special Meetings as needed), 8 hours/month regular activities, separate projects as needed
- Role commitment: 2 years (renewable)

As of 2020 our revenue was under \$5,000 and our day-to-day financial activities are minimal as we are still in the process of reviving our programming. All work will be done remotely using cloud-based software such as QuickBooks Online and Google Workspace. Your valuable contribution will help us ensure Kapisanan's continued growth, so that we can continue to provide much-needed programs to the Filipino/a/x community within the Greater Toronto Area.
